
CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Option 1

From the yellow OR red corduroy fabric cut:

- 3 20 ½" x 3" strips
- 16 3" squares
- 1 20 ½" x 7" piece (for reverse side)
- 1 20 ½" x 9" piece (for reverse side)


Two cushion options provided with relevant cutting instructions for the yellow fabric.



Option 2

From the yellow OR red corduroy fabric cut:

- 2 20 ½" x 1 ¾" strips 5
- 1 20 ½ x 5 ½" piece
- 16 3" squares
- 1 20 ½" x 7" piece (for reverse side)
- 1 20 ½" x 9" piece (for reverse side)



From the cream OR pink corduroy fabric cut:

8 5 ½" x 3" strips





Please read through the pattern instructions in full before you commence sewing. 1/4" seam allowance is used throughout, unless otherwise stated.


Refer to the front cover quilt image for guidance on block layout and fabric placement.


Be mindful of the direction of the grain on the fabric to ensure all pieces lay the same way.

Flying Geese Blocks

Take 1 cream/pink rectangle and 2 yellow/red squares.

Draw a diagonal line from one corner to the other on the reverse side of each square as shown in the diagram.







Place 1 square right sides together on top of the cream/pink rectange, ensuring sides match up.


Sew along the diagonal line.

Trim off excess fabric 1/4" away from sewn line.

Fold out and press.










Take the second yellow/red square and place face down on top of the rectangle. Sew corner to corner along the drawn line.

Trim off excess fabric 1/4"away from sewn line.


Fold out and press.








Make 8 flying geese blocks. Sew together in 2 rows of 4.




Sew the rows together with the 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3"strips as shown in the diagram below.

Sew your cushion together and insert cushion fill to finish.



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
