## First Steps

Quilt Size: 44" x 44" (1.1m x 1.1m)

#### **Cutting Instructions**


- 1 x square at 9" x 9" for the centre
- Border 1 Cut 4 x strips at  $3^{1}/2^{\circ}$  x 20" from the Freya stripe, ensuring the stripes are all the same way
- Border 2 Cut 2 strips at  $6^{1}/2^{\circ}$  x  $14^{1}/2^{\circ}$  and 2 strips at  $6^{1}/2^{\circ}$  x  $26^{1}/2^{\circ}$
- Cross Blocks Background
  - 4 x rectangles at  $4^{1}/_{2}$ " x  $9^{1}/_{2}$ "
  - 8 x rectangles at  $2^{1}/2^{2}$  x  $9^{1}/2^{2}$
  - 48 rectangles at  $3 \times 2^{3}/4$ "
- Each Cross Block Colours
  - 1 x rectangle at  $5 \times 9^{1/2}$ "
  - 2 rectangles at  $4^{1}/2$ " x  $2^{3}/4$ "

#### **Construction Instructions**

#### Step 1 - Border 1

Embroider a design of your choice on the centre square. or create a feature using the broderie purse technique. Once finished, cut back to  $8^{1}/2^{\circ}$  x  $8^{1}/2^{\circ}$ .


Sew the four stripe borders onto your centre square, mitering the corners to join up the stripes.



#### Step 2 - Border 2

Sew on the next border of your plain fabric. Sew the short ones on first, and the long ones on last.






#### Step 3 - Cross Blocks


Sew together the 12 cross blocks as shown below



## Requirements

## Quilt Size: 44" x 44" (1.1m x 1.1m)

- > If you're using a single fabric for the background of the whole quilt
  - 1.2m of Backing fabric (this includes the centre square)
  - 12 x fat 1/6ths from the Forget-me-not Rose range
- > If you're not using a single fabric, the breakdown is as follows
  - > Fat 1/16th for centre
  - > 25cm for Border 1
  - 40cm for Border 2
  - > 65cm for background of cross blocks
  - > 12 x fat 1/16ths for cross block colours
- > 35cm in a Freya stripe for binding
