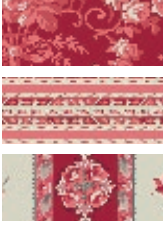

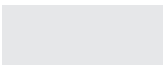
Project size 10CM X 10CM | 4" X 4"

8" X 4" (20cm X 10cm) strip of light weight fusible interfacing (add more interfacing to make several bookmarks).

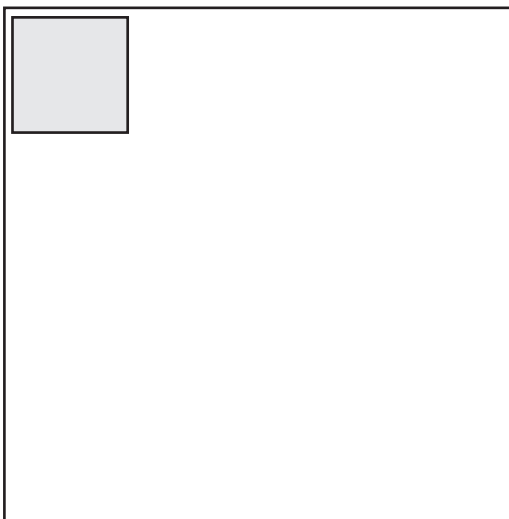
CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

From each of the 3 patterned fat quarters cut:

1 4" X 4" (10cm X 10cm) square.

from the interfacing cut:

2 4" X 4" (10cm X 10cm) squares.



PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Use a ¼" seam allowance throughout, unless otherwise stated.

Iron your interfacing to the reverse side of your chosen back square piece.

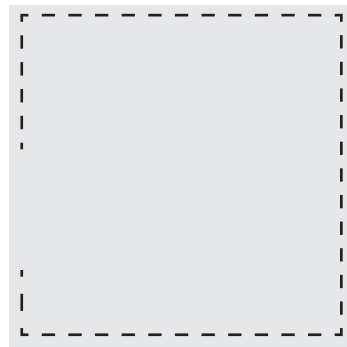
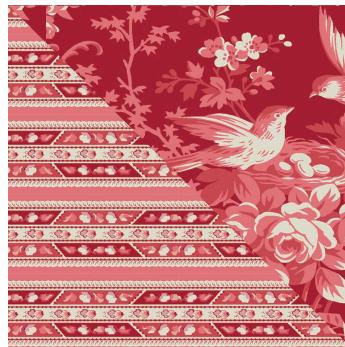
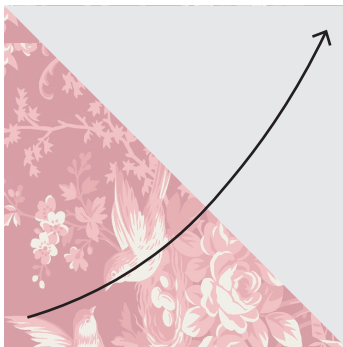
Take the second piece of interfacing and cut in half corner to corner to make a triangle.

Take your chosen fabric square for the corner triangle of the bookmark, lay right side down. Place your triangle piece of interfacing on top and fold your square over to make a triangle, with the interfacing between the layers.

NOTE: If using directional prints, check orientation of fabric first before folding.

Press. Take your non interfaced square right side up, place the interfaced triangle on top, matching raw edges.

Place the interfaced square right side down on top. Sew around the edge, leaving a gap on one side away from the triangle layers.



Clip corners to reduce bulk when turned right side out. Turn right side out, push corners out and press.

Top stitch all the way around, sewing the gap closed as you go. Enjoy your finished bookmark.
