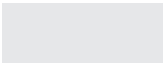

4" X 16 1/2" fleece or wadding

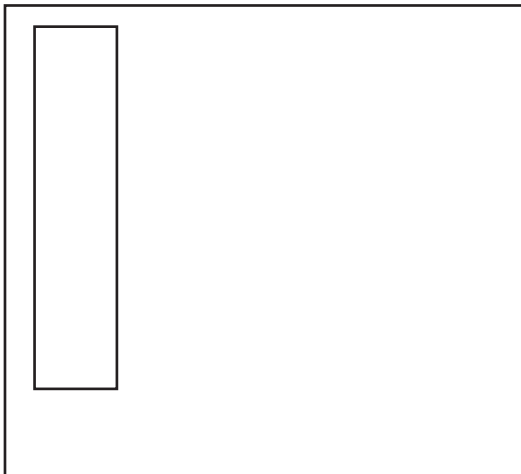


button and thin elastic (approx 3") or hair tie for closure, or velcro

# CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

From 2 patterned fat quarters cut:

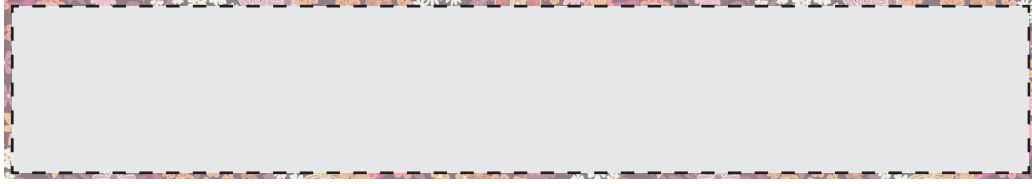
- 1 4" x 16 1/2" (10cm x 42cm) piece.



# PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

**Use a 1/4" seam allowance throughout, unless otherwise stated.**

Sew your fleece or wadding to wrong side of exterior fabric strip.



With exterior fabric facing up, place your lining fabric face down on top, lining up the top edge perfectly. Pin together and mark a curved cutting line 1/4" from the top (use template on next page).

Trim all layers along the cutting line.



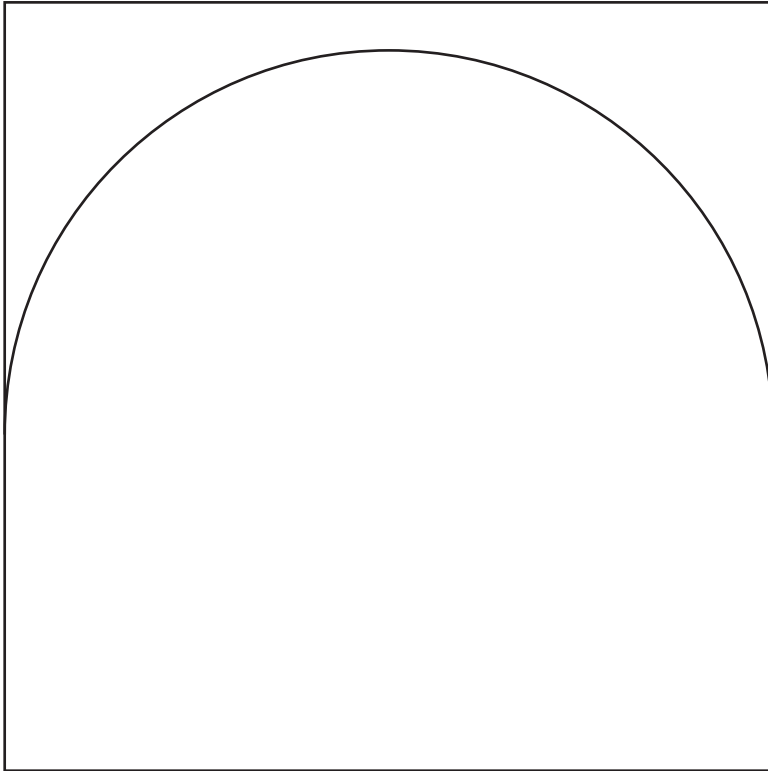
If using elastic and button for closure, place elastic between exterior and lining layers loop facing down. Pin in place.

Pin and sew around the edge of the layers, leaving a 2" gap.

Turn right side out through the unsewn gap, push out the seams and corners.

Press.

# PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

With right side down, fold up the bottom edge towards the top, placing the edge approximately 2 ½" from the top (adjust to desired size for flap).

Press, pin sides in place and topstitch from the bottom left corner all round the edge and top curve back down to the bottom right corner, **making sure to close the gap in the lining as you sew around the edge.**



Measure down for button placement and sew your button in place.

Alternatively add velcro for invisible closure.
