

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Cutting instructions provided are to make the PINK CUSHION shown on pattern cover.


From the DV053 'seeded fabric' (cream) cut: 8 3" squares



CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS


From the green fabric cut:

- 1 3" strip down the short edge of your fat quarter. Crosscut 4 3" squares from this strip.
- 1 20 ½" x 16 ½" (52 X 42cm) piece for cushion back



From the pink fabric cut:

3 5 ½" strips cross cut each strip to create 3 squares from each (9 squares total)




Please read through the pattern instructions in full before you commence sewing. 1/4" seam allowance is used throughout, unless otherwise stated.

Flying Geese Blocks

Take 1 large pink square and 2 cream squares.

Draw a diagonal line from one corner to the other on the reverse side of each cream square as shown in the diagram.







Place 1 cream square right sides together on top of the large pink square, ensuring sides match up.

Sew along the diagonal line.

Trim off excess fabric 1/4" away from sewn line.

Fold back and press.







Take the second cream square and place face down on top of the large pink square. Sew corner to corner along the drawn line.

Trim off excess fabric 1/4" away from sewn line.

Fold back and press.







Make 4 flying geese.

For your centre block, take a pink large square and 4 green 3" squares.


You will sew these in the same way as your flying geese blocks, except you will start in opposite corners as shown.






Assemble your star blocks as shown.

Layout all squares as shown and sew the 3 horizontal strips together




Next sew togher two center rows. Press well



Add batting and quilt cushion top if desired.

Trim batting back to edge of cushion front.



Finish your cushion by sewing your zipper into your back pieces following your prefered method, or follow the suggested tutorial link via the QR code below (Note: if you follow the tutorial suggested, use the option to add fabric to extend your zipper to reduce bulk in the seam).

To Finish Cushion:

Once zipper and flap completed, place back of cushion right side up with ZIPPER OPEN.

Center cushion front on back fabric right sides together. Pin and trim excess back fabric.

Sew around cushion with 1/4" seam.

Turn right side out through zipper, add cushion insert and enjoy!







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
