Can I add to my order?

We can add to orders if they haven't been packed off and invoiced. We endeavour to process orders quickly and efficiently so please call us as soon as possible to avoid disappointment.

Are there any minimum order quantities?

All products have minimum quantities, details are outlined against each item on the website.

Piece lengths

We offer piece lengths of 3mt, 5mt and 10mt + All goods are supplied on blocking boards. Fabrics are cut to length, not ripped.

How do I apply for an account?

Sign up on our website and complete our Wholesale Application Form. or email us at sales@twogreenzebras.com

Minimum opening order value is \$500.00, ex GST

How do I qualify for an account?

When submitting your application, you will need to provide proof of Registered Business, ABN & indicate if you are either a 'bricks and mortar' store or web retailer with an active website. If you are a manufacturer, please specify how your goods are sold.

How will I be notified that my account is opened?

You will receive an auto generated email from our Accounts Department advising you of your account number and log in details to our website. Our team will also give you a call to introduce our business and learn more about yours.

What are your payment terms?

All new accounts will be established as Cash Sales until a regular payment pattern has been established and a credit account is approved. Cash Sale: Payments are required within 14 days from invoice. Approved Credit Account: Strictly net 30 days from invoice.

What payment methods do you accept?

We accept direct deposit and credit cards (Visa and Mastercard) Payment details can be found at the bottom of every invoice and statement.

How are prices displayed?

Access to prices is only granted to customers who are logged into our website with their allocated password.

All prices are shown in AUD on the Australian site and NZD on the New Zealand site.

Prices are shown exclusive of G.S.T, to which will then be applied at the checkout, G.S.T. does not apply to international customers.

Can I cancel an order?

Fabric orders are mostly indent. Fabric orders can be amended up to 7 days after order placement but subsequent to this time will attract a 50% cancellation fee as most fabrics are brought into stock as a result of your request to do so. A back order report can be accessed once logged into the website or emailed out at any time by request

Credit & Returns

No claim allowed for damages or shortages after seven days from the date of receipt of goods. No credit claims will be accepted without prior approval. All agreed items that are returned must be in a saleable condition and a 10% restocking fee may be charged. Return freight will be at the expense of the customer unless prior arrangements have been made with Two Green Zebras Pty Ltd

Shipping and Handling

A freight charge will be applied to each purchase order. Our freight charge is \$23.00 Ex, GST per standard carton. Lesser charges will apply to smaller parcels. Our freight charge is often only a fraction of the true cost to ship the goods to you.

Freight charges for pallets will differ and will be discussed on a per order basis.

Any additional shipping or handling charges that Two Green Zebras incur from the freight company due to inability to deliver goods will be charged to the customer. It is the customers responsibility to advise of change of address or store holidays.

Liberty Fabrics History

Shortly after opening on Regent Street London in 1875, Arthur Liberty became renowned for his silks. By the 1890s Liberty Fabrics was a byword for the very best of avant-garde textile design. Today, every bolt of Liberty fabric is the product of a bespoke production process: hand drawn or painted by the in-house design team in London, Soho. Transformed onto fabric at Liberty's own Italian printing mill, near Lake Como. Liberty Fabrics are created by skilled technicians who oversee the production of over 300 different

designs every year.

Is Liberty Fabrics the same as Liberty of London?

Ever since the Liberty store's founding in 1875, fabrics have laid at the heart of its unique offering. When the doors first opened, Liberty sold fine printed fabrics and silk textiles imported from Asia and the Middle East – prized for their delicate colouration and ultra-fine construction, unlike anything else available in the UK at the time. Shortly Arthur Lasenby Liberty began to experiment with dying and printing textiles in England, and eventually purchased the Merton Print Works in 1904 to develop Liberty's own printed art fabrics – the beginning of the Liberty Fabrics brand as we know it.

History of Tana Lawn®

A famous masterpiece of fabric technology, Tana Lawn® is fine, cool, and durable with a silk-like feel. Made from specially selected ultra-fine, long staple Egyptian cotton, its bespoke process has been fine-tuned by Liberty Fabrics experts over the last 100 years. The qualities of the weave provide a brilliant base material on which to print Liberty's lustrous textile designs. Today, Tana Lawn® continually evolves as Liberty Fabrics works with new technologies and processes to ensure it maintains its reputation as the best printed cotton available.

Where are Liberty Fabrics produced?

Liberty Fabrics are produced in Italy.

What is the width of fabric?

Liberty Tana Lawn: Roll Width (finished/usable): 1.36m/1.33m

Tana Lawn® Washing Care

Liberty Tana Lawn® does not need to be pre-washed before working with it. Because of the high-quality production of the fabric, shrinkage when washing is negligible. While hang drying is preferable, you can also tumble dry on low. Iron on a cotton setting with steam.

Sewing with Liberty Tana Lawn® – what size needle and thread do I use?

For machine sewing Tana Lawn, we suggest a size 70 sewing machine needles, perhaps switching to a size 80 for quilting. When hand-quilting a very small needle, around a size 10. To avoid puckering, you should also make sure you are using a good quality, light weight cotton thread.

What is Tana Lawn?

Composition: 100% Cotton

Roll Width (finished/usable): 1.36m/1.33m

Weight: 76 g/sqm, 104g/lm

Care: Wash 40°C, line dry

This is a cotton that behaves like silk – ultra-fine, with a fluid hand-feel and intense depth of colour that is truly unmatched. An everyday marvel of a dress material, Tana is soft yet durable, cooling yet warming, and even machine washable.

Can I use Liberty Tana Lawn for quilting?

Liberty fabric is suitable for quilting, perfect to create an heirloom project.

What is the difference between Tana Lawn and Liberty Quilting Cottons?

Liberty Quilting Collections, named after the founder of Liberty, Arthur Lasenby Liberty, Lasenby Cotton was designed specifically with crafting in mind. Made from 100% cotton, Lasenby is printed and finished in our Italian Mill near the banks of Lake Como. Slightly heavier than its cotton companion, Tana Lawn™, Lasenby weighs 146 grams per square metre making it very stable and perfect for quilting.

Is Liberty Tana Lawn suitable for dressmaking?

Liberty Tana lawn makes up beautifully into garments. Perfect for shirts, dresses, tops, skirts, nightwear, children's outfits, hats, lining for garments and so much more.
